RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE A SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF SHREWSBURY AND THE TOWNSHIP OF SHREWSBURY FOR EMERGENCY FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq. authorizes municipalities to contract with each other for shared services; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Shrewsbury and the Township of Shrewsbury previously entered into a shared service agreement for emergent fire protection services in 2010, and has renewed this agreement yearly from 2010 through 2017, said agreement of which terminates December 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Shrewsbury ("Borough") and the Township of Shrewsbury ("Township") desires to continue this shared service agreement for fire protection services at an annual fee of \$10,000.00 commencing January 1, 2018 and terminating December 31, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Shrewsbury, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a shared service agreement, prepared by the Township attorney between the Borough of Shrewsbury and the Township of Shrewsbury for emergent fire protection services at an annual fee of \$10,000.00.
