PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Kent Hottmann, resident of Shrewsbury, is currently attending Montclair State University where he is a freshman; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hottmann is a member of Troop 50 of the Monmouth Council Boy Scouts of America, chartered to the Presbyterian Church at Shrewsbury, earning 29 badges ; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hottmann, a 2016 graduate of Red Bank Regional High School, excelled during his high school career. A diligent student earning a GPA of 95/100, he was recognized for his language skills by being inducted into the National Italian Honor Society. Mr. Hottman enjoyed playing both lacrosse and soccer while at RBR. When not working as a delivery driver for Palumbo's, he volunteered his time with 'Bridge of Books', a non- profit organization providing books to underserved children in order to support literacy and foster a love of reading; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hottmann has fulfilled his Eagle Service Project by creating outstanding new sources of playtime educational entertainment for the children at Monmouth Day Care Center in Red Bank. In order to achieve this goal, he had to determine what was possible in the space allowed and identify what the children could safely enjoy while providing new creative learning experiences. Once receiving approval of his proposal, Mr. Hottmann procured his materials, created and hung two 'play walls' made out of plywood for the kids. One wall is musically themed with various materials to make sounds, the other is part magnetic chalkboard with a ball drop maze. Additionally, Mr. Hottmann replaced a picnic bench and painted 'parking spaces' for the kids' toy cars much to their delight; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hottmann, having satisfied the requirements of Boy Scout Troop 50's Board of Review and that of the National Council of the Boy Scouts of America, and having officially attained the Rank of Eagle Scout on the Fifteenth Day of July, Two Thousand Seventeen, the highest and only rank that the Boy Scouts of America permanently confer on young men; and

WHEREAS, Eagle Scouts are recognized throughout the world as leaders in business, government, religion, and society in general.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, that the Borough of Shrewsbury does hereby recognize and congratulate **EAGLE SCOUT KENT HOTTMANN** on the occasion of his Eagle Scout Ceremony; and
