

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-1042

**BOROUGH OF SHREWSBURY
COUNTY OF MONMOUTH**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE
OF THE BOROUGH OF SHREWSBURY BY
AMENDING CHAPTER 118, FIRE PREVENTION**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Shrewsbury, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey.

SECTION 1. That Chapter 118, Fire Prevention, Article I, Uniform Fire Code, § 118-9, Smoke Detector and Carbon Monoxide Alarm Fees and Permit Fees, is amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1

UNIFORM FIRE CODE

§ 118-9. Smoke Detector and Carbon Monoxide Alarm Fees and Permit Fees.

- A. The smoke detector and carbon monoxide alarms certificate fees shall be as follows:
- (1) More than 10 business days with a scheduled appointment: \$45.
 - (2) Four to nine business days with a scheduled appointment: \$90.
 - (3) Less than four business days with a scheduled appointment: \$161.
- B. If a scheduled appointment is not met by the owner/appointee and/or there is a failure to have properly installed or have operating smoke detectors in accordance with the Uniform Fire Code, a fee of \$15 will be added for each reinspection.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.
